GC Preparation for Speaking + Listening

A PRO is a good thing and a CON is a bad thing.

- PRO It keeps everything fair and everyone on the same level
- PRO It develops a sense of community and team spirit in a school.

- CON It can be cold or uncomfortable and not very practical for certain subjects
- CON: Certain uniforms are extremely expensive and can only be worn to school so aren't useful during holidays or at weekends
- CON: Bullying can take place in town centres, parks and public transport between different school when uniform is recognised
- CON: Uniform destroys creativity and personal identity
